From appearance, one may not be able to tell the difference. But the difference is simple, laminate wood orlando fl is not wood! It is a picture of wood that is laminated (the reason why its called laminate) onto an HDF core. The easiest way to decipher the two is this: laminate is paper, a picture of wood that is laminated onto an HDF core, and engineered wood is actual wood. Laminate wood orlando fl is more durable than engineered wood in terms of scratch resistance and denting because of the HDF core.

Engineered wood is cut from an actual tree and laminate is man made product. So the question is, .New laminate wood products look so good, why do people use actual wood?.. There are a few answers to this question. First, laminate wood must be floated, not glued. This creates a .clicking. effect when you walk on the floor. Many people do not like this and find it annoying, or they feel their floor is not solid. Second, there really is no man made substitute to the real thing. Engineered wood is a product of nature, like many things of nature, man has not found a substitute that is able to be created. Also, as previously mention, unlike laminate, engineered wood can be glued down, providing a better, more solid feel. This helps make the floor feel more sturdy and eliminates any hollow sounds when people walk on the floor.
